

Buyer Information

Market Master has provided grain brokerage and consulting services for producers and buyers of grains and oilseeds since 1995. It's simple to buy grain, just give us a call to discuss what you need, including your range of minimum specifications and price. We'll supply the grain that best suits your situation. Buyers can pickup the grain or we can arrange shipping. Brokerage fees are charged to the seller of the grain.

How we work:

Payment:

Payment for grain is to be issued within 10 business days after completion of the contract unless otherwise specified. If the contract is for a larger amount of grain, it may be requested that payment be issued in an interim manner. The buyer is to send the entire cheque to the seller. This is the Gross amount recorded on the Brokers Note.

Time Frames:

Delivery dates should be adhered to as closely as possible. Inclement weather and transportation issues are instances where delivery or pick-up delays are acceptable. Delays due to over-booking of grain may result in storage compensation from the buyer to the producer.

Discounts:

Grain shipped should be of the quality contracted. If grain is below standard, discounts may apply. All discounts are to be discussed with the broker at the time of the issue arising. If you have a discount schedule please provide it. Dockage is 1% of the gross unless otherwise specified.

Contract Cancellation:

Best attempts are made to deliver the contracted grain. If grain is not available, the producer may replace from another source. If another source is not available we work to find the best option for all parties. Please include Market Master in all changes to contracts.

Scheduling:

If the buyer arranges his own freight, we require unloads relayed to the office upon completion and the date that payment has been issued. If the grain is being delivered by a trucker or producer they will contact the buyer directly for scheduling. If problems arise then please contact our office for assistance.

Bid Board:

A current listing of bids from buyers looking to purchase grain. Buyers include end-users, line companies, processors and crushers. Bids may be for spot or forward delivery. Pricing can be available for a year down the road. Buyers can be within the local county to international.
