

Grain Haulers Package

How is grain booked?

Market Master works with many buyers and producers, in different locations, with a variety of grains. Covering Northern to Southern Alberta, BC and the US.

Bids are available for the nearby time period or even a year in advance. Upon the agreement of trucking rates details of the transaction are documented in a Broker's Note and forwarded to all parties involved.

Once a Broker's note is accepted rates are considered booked.

Sometimes buyers may have their own grain trucks or ask Market Master to arrange freight. Often, the producer may prefer to haul his own grain to the end destination. This creates variations in the amount of loads available.

The Broker's Note (BN)

The BN is issued to all parties, reflecting the binding agreement between the buyer and seller and trucker of the grain. Detailed information includes:

- Buyer, seller, hauler
- Pricing
- Grain specifications
- Applicable discounts
- Delivery period

Grain Delivery

It is the responsibility of the trucker to call the buyer/seller to coordinate shipment dates and times. Call the seller at least 48 hours ahead of the shipment date, whenever possible. And if any changes occur to this schedule.

Please inform Market Master once loads have been scheduled.

If you smell unusual odours or notice anything "odd" with the grain when you're loading, please call us immediately. A load that could potentially be rejected should stay on the farm.

Contract Completion

Every effort is made to ensure the contract is completed during the delivery time specified. However, unforeseen circumstances can happen (weather, scheduling, breakdowns) which may delay movement from either the seller's or buyer's end. We all work together to minimize this.

Freight costs are normally based upon a 44 MT load. If there are circumstances with short loads they are dealt with at the time of delivery.

Extra charges may occur if the load is short or loading/unloading takes more than 1.5 hours. The seller or buyer must be informed of this previous to billing.

Fax, email or phone-in scale tickets or weights to us as soon as the contract has been completed.

Payment

Freight bills are to be sent directly to the producer, unless specified.

Grain Standards

When quality issues are in question, grain loads may be rejected or discounts applied. Any occurrences with a quality issue (or issues in general) are dealt with on a case-by-case basis. If you experience a rejected load, please contact Market Master immediately.
